### Here's How It Works:

- \* For every five new memberships (households) you recruit, you will receive a Gift Certificate with the equivalent value of a Family Membership - \$55.
- You have the option to redeem your Gift Certificate(s) for:
  - GWRRR Membership Renewal
  - GWRRR Official Merchandise
  - Wing Ding Registration
  - Chapter Charter Fees



### Find-A-Friend Program Rules:

- Find-A-Friend Program starts **January 1, 2012**.
- Open to all current GWRRR Members. You must recruit new memberships only, not renewals. Each membership counts as “ONE” regardless of the number of family members in the membership. (They will however, count under the Find-A-Friend pin and T-shirt program.)
- Free years are issued and redeemed in the form of a Gift Certificate that is sent by the Home Office upon achieving the count of five new memberships (households).
- Certificates are non-transferable and will have a one year expiration date.
- There is no maximum number of Gift Certificates Members can earn.
- Memberships recruited during special events (mall shows, rallies, motorcycle shows, etc.) qualify for this program.
- Life Members may use the Gift Certificates for GWRRR Official Merchandise, Wing Ding Registration or Charter Fees.
- Free year's membership may be applied towards consecutive years necessary for Life membership.
- Trial membership applications may be used for the recruiting efforts. Membership fees must be paid to qualify for this Find-A-Friend.

*Be SURE to write your name, membership number, and promo code "FAF12" at the bottom of the membership application in order to receive your Find-A-Friend credit. If your new recruits call Member Services to join, please tell them to provide this information to ensure you receive credit.*
