HALL OF FAME



The GWRRA Rider Education Program Hall of Fame recognition was first introduced in 2011 by former International Director of Rider Education Gene Knutson. Three Educators were distinguished in the inaugural class. The goal is to induct one or more Honorees into the Rider Education Program Hall of Fame every year during WING DING.

Unlike the Directors Award Program that is only for current Officers, nominations for this distinguished recognition can include a deserving *current or former* Rider Education officer, instructor, trainer or coordinator for his or her contributions to the GWRRA Rider Education Program and their service to the Members.

Any GWRRA Member may submit a nomination letter however, *we will not accept self-nominations*. Including the following information will assist with the nomination process and support a Member's consideration as a candidate for GWRRA Rider Education Program Hall of Fame recognition:

Required Criteria for Consideration

The candidate will:

- be a GWRRA Member in good standing.
- have served one full year in a Rider Education Program position
- set an example for all GWRRA Members by observing all Rider Education Program guidelines.
- be active and current in the Levels Program at their highest level achieved (unless Levels have been retired)
- actively promote and support the GWRRA Rider Education Program in a positive way both inside and outside their home district.
- be an active or former District Educator; GWRRA Rider Course Instructor, Medic First Aid® Instructor Trainer; Medic First Aid® Instructor; Medic First Aid® Coordinator or Chapter or District Ride Coordinator.
- be someone who has made a significant contribution to the Rider Education Program preferable resulting in benefitting Members both within and beyond the Nominee's home district.

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Additional Factors for Consideration:

Candidate accomplishments are not required selection criteria however, such achievements could be important in the overall selection process. Here are some options to think about:

- List the Rider Education Program position(s) the Nominee has held or currently holds.
- Describe his or her qualifications, duties and level of success in the position(s).
- Include other training and certifications the Candidate has. For example: University Trainer or University Instructor or a trainer/instructor in an alternative FA/CPR or rider training program recognized by the GWRRA Rider Education Program.
- Describe the candidate's attitude, communication and relationship skills. Provide examples of ways he or she has gone above and beyond to serve GWRRA Members.
- Explain how the Nominee's personal enjoyment of GWRRA activities is made evident to other Members.

Include the Nominator's Name, Member Number, District; Chapter and current position held, if applicable. Please also include an email address and a telephone number as well as the candidate's full name, Member Number, District and Chapter designation.

All Nomination letters should be received by the Director of Rider Education no later than **April 1, 2020**. The induction and award presentation will take place during Wing Ding.

Rider Education Program Hall of Fame inductees receive an award plaque, framed certificate and the Hall of Fame Member rocker patch.
