Motorcycle #1

Rider: Currently Qualified as Road Captain

Co-rider: Open

Motorcycle #2

Rider: Able to attempt to safely control traffic, assertive style

Co-rider: Has cell phone that is FULLY charged.

Motorcycle #3

Rider: Able to comfortably lie on asphalt for as long as 30 minutes, pretending to be unconscious the entire time, until tucked away in the ambulance. Will wear makeup consisting of fake blood from nose and corner of mouth.

Co-rider: Able to comfortably lie on asphalt for as long as 30 minutes, pretending to be unconscious for about 5 minutes after the curtain opens. Willingness to act realistically.

Motorcycle #4

Rider: Able to attempt to safely control traffic, assertive style

Co-rider: Certified BLS, with First Aid Kit in bike

Motorcycle #5

Rider: No specific requirements

Co-rider: No specific requirements

Motorcycle #6

Rider: Able to attempt to safely control traffic, assertive style

Co-rider: Certified BLS, with First Aid Kit in bike

Motorcycle #7

Rider: Certified Road Captain, able to serve as Scene Coordinator, assertive style

Co-rider: Able to walk to Group Keeper location
