

MFA CLASS STATUS UPDATE

Effective: July 8th, 2020

Beginning on July 8th, 2020, the decision to start offering MFA classes will be *made by the individual Districts*. Because there are still Covid-19 “pop up” cases in different areas throughout the US, it is *recommended* to follow the current CDC guidelines, state, and local recommendations for the safety of GWRRA Members and MFA Instructors.

Attached a MFA Q&A sheet, the current GWRRA MFA Guidelines for conducting classes and information about using bleach as a disinfectant. Note: if there is a concern about floor contamination, newspaper may be used to cover an area. You are free to use your judgement to teach safely.

Please note: *HSI has provided a Limited extension of GWRRA MFA Instructor expiration dates that GWRRA cannot extend further. Please take that into consideration when you schedule Instructors to teach.*
